**Parental Information (Preliminary)**

Thank you for enabling your son or daughter to participate in our 2010 NoCO Youth River Conservation & Fly Fishing Day Camp. Members of Rocky Mountain Flycasters are committed to helping America's young people regain an awareness of and interest in enjoying the pleasures of natural outdoors experiences. It is our hope that they will also recognize how important it is for us to protect and preserve these resources and that they will become responsible, conservation-minded adults.

This preliminary information sheet will be updated and provided again when your son/daughter is accepted.

- Parents are welcome to stay and observe activities and classes, though in some settings there may not be adequate space to accommodate all observers safely or comfortably.
- Day Camp will be conducted in two sequential Thursday-Friday-Saturday segments on July 15-17 and 22-24. Class or activities will begin at 8:00AM and end at 6:00PM daily. Any variances from this tentative schedule will be available before the Day Camp begins.
- Youths will pack and bring their lunch each day. We will provide coolers for them to be stored.
- Classes will be conducted at Fort Collins public meeting room and school and park facilities, and most field activities will be conducted on Poudre River lower canyon stretches or at Larimer County Natural Areas. The conservation project and possibly one other special field activity will be conducted at locations further away.
- Parents are responsible for transporting, or arranging for transportation, of the youths to and from class and activities locations. We are beginning to arrange transportation for the conservation project and special field activity that may be a bit more distant. Detailed location and transportation schedule information will be available before the Day Camp begins.
- Classes and instructions will be presented by professional staff from the Colorado Division of Wildlife, US Fish & Wildlife Service, US Bureau of Natural Resources and qualified members of the Rocky Mountain Flycasters Chapter.
- Equipment and supplies will be provided by the Rocky Mountain Flycasters Chapter.
- A Parental/Guardian Consent Form is required to be completed and signed before a youth can participate in any Day Camp activities or classes. If a significant physical impairment exists, and depending upon the specific requirements, the parent or guardian may be required to provide a qualified caretaker.
- In the unlikely instance that a youth's behavior becomes disruptive or unsafe, and he/she does not respond satisfactorily to counsel from the responsible Day Camp adult, the youth will be removed from any further participation and it will be necessary to contact the parent or guardian to come and permanently remove the youth from the Day Camp program.
